A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the courts; permitting courts to enter
2 stipulated protective orders as specified; and providing
3 for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-3-509 by creating a new subsection
8 (d) and 35-21-105 by creating a new subsection (k) are
9 amended to read:

11 **7-3-509. Order of protection; contents; remedies;**
12 **order not to affect title to property.**

14 (d) A respondent may make a knowing and voluntary
15 stipulation that a court may exercise jurisdiction over the

1 respondent and issue an order pursuant to this section
2 without a hearing, factual finding or admission that the
3 conduct giving rise to the petition occurred. An order
4 entered pursuant to this section without a hearing, factual
5 finding or admission that the conduct giving rise to the
6 petition occurred shall be valid and enforceable and have
7 the same force and effect as a protective order entered
8 with findings of fact and conclusions of law.

10 **35-21-105. Order of protection; contents; remedies;**
11 **order not to affect title to property; conditions.**

13 (k) A respondent may make a knowing and voluntary
14 stipulation that a court may exercise jurisdiction over the
15 respondent and issue an order pursuant to this section
16 without a hearing, factual finding or admission that the
17 conduct giving rise to the petition occurred. An order
18 entered pursuant to this section without a hearing, factual
19 finding or admission that the conduct giving rise to the
20 petition occurred shall be valid and enforceable and have
21 the same force and effect as a protective order entered
22 with findings of fact and conclusions of law.
