Grants or loans may be applied 2 for by a joint powers board with the approval of all participating agencies to the joint powers agreement. 3 4 Grants and loans may be made by the council for economic or 5 educational development, planning or infrastructure projects, including the purchase of land, 6 buildings, facilities, telecommunications infrastructure, rights of 7 way, airports, sewer and water projects, roads, 8 9 landscaping, recreational and convention facilities or 10 other infrastructure determined by the council to be 11 consistent with the purposes of this article. In adopting rules and making grants and loans under this article the 12 13 council shall require all projects to be related to or educational development, planning or 14 economic infrastructure, which shall not include rehabilitation or 15 expansion of existing infrastructure unless the council 16 17 determines the rehabilitation or expansion is necessary to meet the purposes of this article. All grants, loans or 18 cooperative agreements made under this article shall be 19 20 referred by the council to the state loan and investment 21 board for final approval or disapproval. The state loan and 22 investment board may adopt rules as necessary to implement its duties under this article. 23
