Ignition interlock license amendments.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to restricted drivers' licenses; modifying
2 requirements relating to driving under the influence and
3 the use of ignition interlock devices; amending the periods
4 during which ignition interlock devices are required; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-233 by creating a new subsection
10 (n) and 31-7-403(c) (ii) are amended to read:

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12 **31-5-233. Driving or having control of vehicle while**
13 **under influence of intoxicating liquor or controlled**
14 **substances; penalties.**

1 (n) The time periods for a required ignition
2 interlock device, as specified in paragraphs (f)(ii)
3 through (iv) of this section, shall not include any time
4 period during which the person required to operate only
5 vehicles equipped with an ignition interlock device is not
6 licensed to operate a motor vehicle or is under suspension
7 or revocation.

9 **31-7-403. Suspension or revocation of ignition**
10 **interlock license.**

12 (c) Subject to the administrative hearing provisions
13 of W.S. 31-7-105, the department may revoke a person's
14 ignition interlock restricted license when the department
15 is notified that:

16
17 (ii) The monthly reports from a licensee's
18 ignition interlocking device data logger indicate that the
19 licensee is habitually attempting to operate a vehicle
20 while impaired. Following revocation under this paragraph,
21 any subsequent license issued to the licensee shall be
22 subject to the ignition interlock requirements of this

1 article for an additional period equal to the original
2 period plus six (6) months.

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
