Capitol oversight group membership.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state property and buildings; providing  
2 for the gubernatorial appointment of additional members to  
3 the state capitol building rehabilitation and restoration  
4 project oversight group; providing for terms of appointed  
5 members; providing for removal of appointed members;  
6 providing for mileage and per diem of appointed members;  
7 providing for appointed members to be included as a quorum  
8 of the oversight group; providing a method for appointed  
9 members votes to be counted for actions of the oversight  
10 group; and providing for an effective date.

12 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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1           **Section 1.** W.S. 9-5-111(a) by creating a new  
2 paragraph (v), (b) and by creating a new subsection (f) and  
3 9-5-112(f) are amended to read:

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5           **9-5-111. State capitol building rehabilitation and**  
6 **restoration project oversight group; creation; duties.**

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8           (a) There is created a state capitol building  
9 rehabilitation and restoration oversight group comprised  
10 of:

11  
12                   (v) Two (2) persons appointed by the governor  
13 and confirmed by the senate pursuant to W.S. 28-12-101,  
14 with experience regarding the project.

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16           (b) A quorum of the oversight group shall consist of  
17 the governor and a majority of the legislative and  
18 appointed members of the oversight group. Except for  
19 approvals under W.S. 9-5-112(e) and (f), actions of the  
20 oversight group may be taken by vote of a majority of all  
21 the legislative and appointed members in attendance or by  
22 their proxy vote and the governor.

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1       (f) Members appointed to the oversight group pursuant  
2 to paragraph (a)(v) of this section shall serve on the  
3 oversight group until December 31, 2019. Appointed members  
4 shall receive mileage and per diem in the same manner and  
5 amount as state legislators while performing duties of the  
6 oversight group. Appointed members to the oversight group  
7 may be removed by the governor as provided by W.S. 9-1-202.

9       **9-5-112. Capitol building rehabilitation and**  
10 **restoration project; components; oversight.**

11  
12       (f) The department may expend funds appropriated by  
13 the legislature for the project to implement the design,  
14 renovation, restoration, rehabilitation, construction and  
15 other project components which have been included in the  
16 final design plans approved under subsection (e) of this  
17 section. Any change order to the approved final design  
18 plans in excess of one hundred thousand dollars  
19 (\$100,000.00) or in a cumulative amount in excess of one  
20 million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall require the approval  
21 of a majority of all the legislative and appointed members  
22 of the oversight group and the governor.

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1           **Section 2.** 2014 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 40,  
2 Section 4(e) is amended to read:

4           **Section 4.**

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6           (e) There is appropriated from the capitol  
7 building rehabilitation and restoration account  
8 to the legislative service office ninety-five  
9 thousand dollars (\$95,000.00) for per diem,  
10 salary and mileage of legislators and the per  
11 diem and mileage of appointed members serving on  
12 the capitol building rehabilitation and  
13 restoration oversight group or advisory task  
14 force and for mileage and per diem for advisory  
15 task force members appointed under W.S.  
16 9-5-109(m) (iv).

18           **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon  
19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
21 Constitution.
