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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 8 **Section 1.** On the effective date of this act, the state
- 9 auditor shall transfer seven million dollars (\$7,000,000.00)
- 10 from unexpended, unobligated funds within the general fund,
- 11 or as much thereof as is available, to water development

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12 account II created by W.S. 41-2-124(a)(ii).

14 Section 2.

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1 (a) The following sums of money are appropriated from 2 the general fund to the following accounts for the purposes 3 specified: 4 5 Two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) to water (i) development account I created by W.S. 41-2-124(a)(i) for the 6 purpose of providing funding for the groundwater exploration 7 8 program authorized by W.S. 41-2-119; 9 10 (ii) Twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000.00) 11 to water development account I created by W.S. 41-2-124(a)(i) 12 for the purpose of acquiring water storage capacity in 13 Fontenelle reservoir. The Wyoming water development office is hereby authorized to negotiate a purchase agreement with the 14 15 bureau of reclamation to acquire water storage capacity in 16 Fontenelle reservoir. No funds shall be expended from this 17 appropriation until the negotiated purchase agreement is approved by the Wyoming water development commission, the 18 19 governor and the legislature;

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21 (iii) Twenty-one million eight hundred ten 22 thousand dollars (\$21,810,000.00) to water development 23 account II created by W.S. 41-2-124(a)(ii) for the Goshen

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1 irrigation district tunnels 1 and 2 rehabilitation water

2 development project. No funds shall be expended from this

3 appropriation until the legislature authorizes the project as

4 a water development program construction project;

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6 (iv) Two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) to water

7 development account II created by W.S. 41-2-124(a)(ii) for

8 the purpose of funding the sponsor's contingency fund as

9 authorized in W.S. 99-3-1106(b);

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11 (v) Thirty million dollars (\$30,000,000.00) to

12 water development account II created by W.S. 41-2-124(a)(ii)

13 for the purpose of the LaPrele dam rehabilitation water

14 development project. No funds shall be expended from this

15 appropriation until the legislature authorizes the project as

16 a water development program construction project.

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18 (b) Funds appropriated under subsection (a) of this

19 section shall not be transferred or expended for any other

20 purpose. Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e) or

21 9-4-207, unexpended, unobligated general funds appropriated

22 under subsection (a) of this section shall revert to the water

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1 development account to which they were appropriated on July

2 1, 2032.

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4 **Section 3.** W.S. 41-2-119(a), 99-3-1106(b)(iv) and (vii)

5 and 99-3-2205(d)(vii) and (e)(vii) are amended to read:

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7 41-2-119. Groundwater studies.

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9 The Wyoming water development commission may grant 10 not to exceed eight million eight hundred thousand dollars 11 (\$8,800,000.00) ten million eight hundred thousand dollars 12 (\$10,800,000.00) to incorporated cities and towns, water and sewer districts and improvement and service districts in 13 Wyoming for exploration for and feasibility studies of the 14 use of underground water for municipal and rural domestic 15 16 purposes, not to exceed four hundred thousand dollars 17 (\$400,000.00) for any one (1) exploration or study. grants shall be made from revenues from water development 18 19 account I and those revenues are hereby so appropriated. Any 20 city or town, water and sewer district or service and 21 improvement district receiving a grant pursuant to this section shall provide at least twenty-five percent (25%) of 22 the cost of the exploration or study from its own funds. 23

(vii) Appropriation: There is appropriated from the general fund to the commission thirty-five million dollars (\$35,000,000.00) to carry out the purpose of this subsection. There is appropriated from water development account III to the commission fifty nine million dollars (\$59,000,000.00) twenty-four million dollars (\$24,000,000.00) or as much thereof as is necessary to carry out the purpose of this subsection. Unexpended funds appropriated under this subsection shall revert to water development account III on July 1, 2025 2032.

(e) Project - Leavitt Reservoir Expansion:

the general fund to the commission thirty million dollars (\$30,000,000.00) to carry out the purpose of this subsection.

There is appropriated from water development account III to the commission forty-six million dollars (\$46,000,000.00) sixteen million dollars (\$16,000,000.00) or as much thereof as is necessary to carry out the purpose of this subsection.

1 Unexpended funds appropriated under this subsection shall

2 revert to water development account III on July 1, 2025 2032.

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4 Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon

5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as

6 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
