Controlled substance prescription tracking.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to controlled substances; requiring certain  
2 health care practitioners to file prescriptions for  
3 controlled substances with the state board of pharmacy as  
4 specified; providing for the enrollment of specified health  
5 care practitioners in the controlled substance prescription  
6 tracking program; providing rulemaking authority; and  
7 providing for an effective date.

9 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

11 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-1025(c) and 35-7-1060(b) are  
12 amended to read:

1           **35-7-1025. Registration of manufacturers and**  
2 **distributors; controlled substance prescription tracking**  
3 **program enrollment.**

5           (c) Practitioners ~~must~~shall be registered to  
6 dispense any controlled substances or to conduct research  
7 with controlled substances in Schedules II through V if  
8 they are authorized to dispense or conduct research under  
9 the law of this state. The board need not require separate  
10 registration under this article for practitioners engaging  
11 in research with nonnarcotic controlled substances in  
12 Schedules II through V where the registrant is already  
13 registered under this article in another capacity.  
14 Practitioners registered under federal law to conduct  
15 research with Schedule I substances may conduct research  
16 with Schedule I substances within this state upon  
17 furnishing the board evidence of that federal registration.

18 The board shall enroll any practitioner registered under  
19 this subsection in the controlled substance prescription  
20 tracking program maintained by the board under W.S.  
21 35-7-1060 if the practitioner is authorized to dispense any  
22 controlled substances in Schedules II through V. The board

1 may promulgate rules and regulations for purposes of  
2 enrolling those practitioners in the tracking program.

7 (b) ~~All prescriptions~~ A dispenser shall  
8 electronically file with the board information regarding  
9 any prescription for a schedule II, III, ~~and IV~~ or V  
10 controlled ~~substances dispensed by any retail pharmacy~~  
11 ~~licensed by the board shall be filed with the board~~  
12 ~~electronically or by other means required by the board~~  
13 substance dispensed by the dispenser no later than the  
14 close of business on the business day immediately following  
15 the day the controlled substance was dispensed. The board  
16 may grant a reasonable time extension to a dispenser who is  
17 unable to electronically file information required under  
18 this subsection. The board may require the filing of other  
19 prescriptions and may specify the manner in which the  
20 prescriptions are filed. The board may, by rule and  
21 regulation, exempt from the requirements of this subsection  
22 prescriptions dispensed in certain inpatient health care  
23 settings, as determined by the board in consultation with

1 other professional licensing boards that license  
2 practitioners.

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2018.
