A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; providing that a concealed
2 carry permit is acceptable identification for purposes of
3 in person voter identification requirements; and providing
4 for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-1-102(a)(xxxix)(B) by creating a
9 new subdivision (X) is amended to read:

11 **22-1-102. Definitions.**

13 (a) The definitions contained in this chapter apply
14 to words and phrases used in this Election Code and govern
15 the construction of those words and phrases unless they are

1 specifically modified by the context in which they appear.

2 As used in this Election Code:

4 (xxxix) "Acceptable identification" means:

6 (B) For purposes of in person voter
7 identification immediately before voting at a polling place
8 or absentee polling place, any of the following:

10 (X) A valid permit issued by the state
11 of Wyoming to carry a concealed firearm.

13 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2023.
