A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; amending requirements for
2 certain complimentary hunting licenses; and providing for
3 an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

6

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-705(e)(i) and (ii) is amended to
8 read:

9

10 **23-1-705. Complimentary licenses; one-shot antelope**
11 **hunt licenses; gunpowder and buckskin hunt licenses;**
12 **gratuitous licenses; donated licenses.**

14 (e) The department shall issue:

15

16 (i) For a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) a resident
17 deer, antelope or wild turkey license and for a fee of five

1 dollars (\$5.00) an elk license to any resident who ~~was born~~
2 ~~on or before January 1, 1930,~~ is at least seventy-five (75)
3 years of age prior to the issuance of the license and who
4 has continuously resided in Wyoming for at least the ~~forty~~
5 ~~(40)~~ fifty (50) years immediately preceding application for
6 the license;

7

8 (ii) For a fee established by rule of the
9 commission a resident deer, antelope, wild turkey or elk
10 license to any resident who ~~was born after January 1, 1930,~~
11 is at least seventy (70) years of age prior to the issuance
12 of the license and has continuously resided in Wyoming for
13 at least fifty (50) years immediately preceding application
14 for the license. The fee established for a license under
15 this paragraph shall be not more than sixty-five percent
16 (65%) nor less than sixty percent (60%) of the resident fee
17 specified in W.S. 23-2-101 for the particular species;

19 **Section 2.** This act is effective January 1, 2013.
