Allocation of complimentary hunting licenses.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; limiting allocation of  
2 certain complimentary licenses as specified; providing  
3 rulemaking authority; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-705(g) is amended to read:

8

9 **23-1-705. Complimentary licenses; one-shot antelope**  
10 **hunt licenses; gunpowder and buckskin hunt licenses;**  
11 **gratuitous licenses; donated licenses.**

13 (g) In addition to complimentary licenses under  
14 subsection (a) of this section, each appointed commissioner  
15 may cause to be issued at cost not more than a total of  
16 eight (8) elk, deer or antelope designated licenses per

1 year. All licenses issued under this subsection shall be  
2 designated to nonprofit charitable organizations. As a  
3 condition of accepting the license, the organization shall  
4 agree to either auction or otherwise bid the license to the  
5 highest bidder or to raffle the license to members of the  
6 public. The number of licenses issued under this subsection  
7 to be disbursed by auction or bid shall not exceed ten  
8 percent (10%) of the total licenses by license type  
9 allocated in that year in any given hunt area for the  
10 applicable species and shall be issued on a first come,  
11 first serve basis. The commission shall promulgate rules  
12 and regulations to implement the requirements of this  
13 subsection.

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2017.
