(b) An individual who performs service for wages is 1 2 an employee for purposes of this act unless it is shown that the individual either: 3 4 5 (vi) May substitute another individual to 6 perform his services; - or 7 (vii) Is free from control or direction over the 8 9 details of the performance of services by contract and by 10 fact; and 11 12 (viii) Has substantial investment used in connection with the performance of the services. The 13 14 investment may include physical assets, financial assets, education, experience, intellectual property or any 15 16 combination of these factors. 17 18 27-14-102.
