- 9 subsection (d), 12-4-404 and 12-4-405 are amended to read:

- 11 12-4-401. Resort retail liquor licenses; authorized;
- 12 qualifications; provision for licenses issued prior to
- 13 January 1, 1980.

1	(a) The appropriate licensing authority in a county,
2	city or town may issue resort retail liquor licenses to
3	applicants who are owners or lessees of a resort complex
4	where the resort complex satisfies the requirements of
5	subsection (b) of this section and to applicants who are
6	nonprofit organizations that satisfy the requirements of
7	subsection (d) of this section.
8	
9	(d) To qualify for a resort liquor license, the
10	appropriate licensing authority shall require a nonprofit
11	organization to:
12	
13	(i) Describe the dedicated location where it
14	will sell alcoholic or malt beverages;
15	
16	(ii) Demonstrate that its purpose is fraternal,
17	charitable, religious or public service;
18	
19	(iii) Demonstrate that it is exempt from federal
20	income tax pursuant to section 501(c) of the Internal
21	Revenue Code.

The dispensing of alcoholic or malt 9 beverages licensed to be sold hereunder shall be controlled by W.S. 12-5-201 and if a catering permit has been issued 10 by W.S. 12-4-502 (b). 11 12 13 (b) Resort liquor licensees licensed that are nonprofit organizations may permit closed container items 14 15 sold at an auction for the benefit of a nonprofit 16 organization to be taken off of the licensee's premises. 17 12-4-405.
