AN ACT relating to abandoned vehicles; increasing the storage expense fee; and providing for an effective date.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

**Section 1.** W.S. 31-13-109(g) is amended to read:

**31-13-109. Disposition of vehicles left unattended on private property and sold by the property owner or through a court action.**

(g) At any time prior to a sale under this section, the owner or lienholder of record may reclaim the vehicle upon payment of expenses incident to removal, preservation, custody, storage and sale, and if a vehicle was left unattended at an establishment for service, repair or maintenance, the cost of the services. Storage expenses shall be computed at the rate of ~~five dollars (\$5.00)~~ ten dollars (\$10.00) per day.
