A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public utilities; requiring electric
2 utilities to enter into a service agreement with certain
3 customers as specified; making conforming amendments; and
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-3-116(a)(intro), (d)(i) and by
9 creating a new subsection (e) is amended to read:

10

11 **37-3-116. Electric utility service agreements.**

12

13 (a) An electric utility may, subject to subsection
14 (e) of this section, enter into a service agreement as
15 specified in subsection (d) of this section, provided that
16 the terms and conditions of the agreement:

2 (d) This section shall only apply to service
3 agreements:

4

5 (i) Between an electric utility and a customer
6 with projected electric usage greater than five (5)
7 megawatts. Subsection (e) of this section shall apply to a
8 customer with projected electric usage greater than one
9 hundred (100) megawatts;

10

11 (e) An electric utility shall enter into a service
12 agreement under subsection (a) of this section if:

13

14 (i) A customer request for a new service on or
15 after July 1, 2025 has a projected electric usage greater
16 than one hundred (100) megawatts;

17

18 (ii) An existing customer request for additional
19 service on or after July 1, 2025 has a projected
20 incremental electric usage greater than one hundred (100)
21 megawatts.

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2025.
