State superintendent of public instruction.

A BILL

for

A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
Constitution relating to the superintendent of public
instruction; eliminating the elected status of the state
superintendent on and after January 5, 2019; providing for

5 supervision of public schools by the governor through

6 appointed cabinet officer; designating the appointed

7 officer as ex officio member of University of Wyoming board

8 of trustees; removing the state superintendent from the

9 board of land commissioners on and after January 5, 2019.

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,

12 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting

13 separately, concurring therein:

1 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming

2 Constitution, Article 4, Section 11, Article 7, Sections

3 11, 14 and 17 and Article 18, Section 3 are proposed for

4 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the

5 next general election for approval or rejection to become

6 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a

7 majority of the electors at the election:

8

9 Article 4, Section 11. State officers; election;

10 qualifications; terms.

There shall be chosen by the qualified electors of the 12 13 state at the times and places of choosing members of the legislature, a secretary of state, auditor, treasurer, and 14 superintendent of public instruction, who shall have 15 attained the age of twenty-five (25) years respectively, 16 17 shall be citizens of the United States, and shall have the qualifications of state electors. They shall severally 18 hold their offices at the seat of government, for the term 19 20 of four (4) years and until their successors are elected 21 and duly qualified. Commencing with the 2018 general 22 election, the state superintendent of public instruction shall not be elected and on and after January 5, 2019 the 23

general supervision of public schools pursuant to Article

- 1 7, Section 14 of this constitution, shall be entrusted to
- 2 the governor and his appointee. The legislature may
- 3 provide for such other state officers as are deemed
- 4 necessary.

5

6 Article 7, Section 11. Textbooks.

7

- 8 Neither the legislature, nor while the office exists the
- 9 superintendent of public instruction, nor the governor or
- 10 his appointee under Article 7, Section 14 of this
- 11 constitution, shall have power to prescribe text books to
- 12 be used in the public schools.

13

- 14 Article 7, Section 14. Supervision of schools
- 15 entrusted to governor; cabinet officer appointment.

16

- 17 (a) Until January 5, 2019, the general supervision of
- 18 the public schools shall be entrusted to the state
- 19 superintendent of public instruction, whose powers and
- 20 duties shall be prescribed by law.

21

- 22 (b) On and after January 5, 2019, the general
- 23 supervision of the public schools of Wyoming shall be
- 24 entrusted to the governor. The governor shall appoint a

- 1 cabinet officer of the executive branch of state government
- 2 to represent the governor in his role to supervise the
- 3 public schools of this state. The cabinet officer shall be
- 4 appointed by and with the advice and consent of the senate,
- 5 and his powers and duties shall be as prescribed by law.

6

7 Article 7, Section 17. Government of university.

8

- 9 The legislature shall provide by law for the management of
- 10 the university, its lands and other property by a board of
- 11 trustees, consisting of not less than seven members, to be
- 12 appointed by the governor by and with the advice and
- 13 consent of the senate, and the president of the university,
- 14 and until January 4, 2019, the superintendent of public
- 15 instruction, as members ex officio, as such having the
- 16 right to speak, but not to vote. On and after January 5,
- 17 2019, the cabinet officer appointed by the governor under
- 18 Article 7, Section 14 of this constitution, shall
- 19 constitute an ex officio member of the board of trustees.
- 20 The duties and powers of the trustees shall be prescribed
- 21 by law.

23 Article 18, Section 3. Board of land commissioners.

1 Until January 4, 2019, the governor, secretary of state, state treasurer, state auditor and superintendent of public 2 3 instruction shall constitute а board of land 4 commissioners., which On and after January 5, 2019, the 5 governor, secretary of state, state treasurer and state auditor shall constitute the board. The board, under 6 legislature as limited 7 direction of the by constitution, shall have direction, control, leasing and 8 9 disposal of lands of the state granted, or which may be 10 hereafter granted for the support and benefit of public 11 schools, subject to the further limitations that the sale of all lands shall be at public auction, after such delay 12 13 (not less than the time fixed by congress) in portions at proper intervals of time, and at such minimum prices (not 14 less than the minimum fixed by congress) as to realize the 15 largest possible proceeds. And said board, subject to the 16 17 limitations of this constitution and under such regulations as may be provided by law shall have the direction, 18 control, disposition and care of all lands that have been 19 20 heretofore or may hereafter be granted to the state.

22 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse 23 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

The adoption of this amendment eliminates the state 1 2 superintendent of public instruction as an elected official 3 commencing with the general election in 2018. Effective 4 January 5, 2019 the general supervision of Wyoming public 5 schools will be under the governor through an appointed cabinet level officer by and with the advice and consent of 6 the Wyoming senate. Effective January 5, 2019, the state 7 board of land commissioners will be reduced from five to 8 9 four members and the appointed cabinet level officer will become an ex officio member of the University of Wyoming 10 board of trustees. 11
