6 WHEREAS, the Tenth Amendment to the United States 7 Constitution states "The powers not delegated to the United 8 States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the 9 states, are reserved to the states respectively, or to the 10 people"; and

12 WHEREAS, the United States Constitution does not delegate 13 the power over education to the United States, it is a 14 power reserved to the states or the people; and

WHEREAS, the authority and power of the United States 1 2 government over education shall not increase with the 3 creation of the United States department of education; and 4 WHEREAS, the United States government shall not diminish 5 the power over education reserved to the states or local 6 school systems or other instrumentalities of the states; 7 8 and 9 10 WHEREAS, the United States government shall not impose 11 unfunded mandates, sanctions, financial or otherwise, 12 against the educational institutions of the states, or the 13 states, respectively. 14 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE16 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING: 17 Section 1. That procedures be instituted in Congress 18 19 to add a new Article to the Constitution of the United 20 States, and that Congress prepare and submit to the several 21 states an amendment to the United States Constitution that
