- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming

- 10 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
- 11 Constitution, Article 3, Section 6 is proposed for
- 12 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
- 13 next general election for approval or rejection to become
- 14 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
- 15 majority of the electors at the election:

1 Article 3, Section 6. Compensation of members;

2 duration of sessions.

3

The legislature shall not meet for more than sixty (60) 4 5 legislative working days excluding Sundays during the term for which members of the house of representatives are 6 7 elected, except when called into special session. The legislature shall determine by statute the number of days 8 not to exceed sixty (60) legislative working days to be 9 devoted to general and budget session, respectively. The 10 11 legislature shall meet on odd-numbered years for a general 12 and budget session. The legislature may meet on even-13 numbered years for budget session. During the budget 14 session no bills except the budget bills may be introduced unless placed on call by a two-thirds vote of 15 either house. The legislature shall meet for no more than 16 17 forty (40) legislative working days excluding Sundays in 18 any (1) calendar year, except when called into special session. The compensation of the members of the legislature 19 shall be as provided by law; but no legislature shall fix 20 21 its own compensation.

1 Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse

2 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

4 In 1972, Article 3, Section 6 of the Wyoming Constitution

5 was amended to allow the Wyoming Legislature to hold a

6 budget session. The ballot statement summarizing the 1972

7 amendment stated: "In addition, it provides that during the

8 budget session no bills except budget bills may be

9 considered unless placed on call by a special two-thirds

10 vote of either house." However the language of the

11 amendment itself apparently inadvertently stated "no bills

12 except the budget bill may be introduced" except upon two-

13 thirds vote. The adoption of this amendment eliminates

14 that difference and aligns the language with the 1972

15 ballot statement, thereby clarifying that the legislature

16 may consider more than one budget bill without a two-thirds

17 introduction vote.
